

Changes in the Executive Vice Presidency of Engineering of BBVA Colombia

At its ordinary meeting today, the Board of Directors resolved to appoint Katherine Duque Quiroga as Executive Vice President of Engineering, effective July, replacing Gregorio Blanco Mesa, who is leaving BBVA Colombia to take on new professional projects at BBVA S.A. (Spain).

Katherine holds a degree in Systems and Computing Engineering from Universidad del Quindío and a specialization in Engineering Management Systems from Universidad Javeriana. She has over 18 years of experience leading technological transformation processes in the financial sector. She joined BBVA in 2021, where she headed the Retail Directorate, leading the technological evolution of digital and physical channels. Since 2024, she had been serving as Digital Transformation Strategy Leader in the Retail Banking Vice Presidency.
